**About the Event** The UConn Sports Analytics Symposium (UCSAS) stands out in the landscape of sports analytics conferences by offering an accessible platform for students. Since its inception in Fall 2019, UCSAS has become a vibrant forum for the sports analytics community, facilitating the exchange of ideas among participants from the New England area, across the nation, and around the globe. Despite the challenges posed by the pandemic, which led to virtual events in 2020 and 2021, UCSAS continued to foster engagement and learning. The symposium triumphantly returned to inperson format in 2022, supported by the National Science Foundation to enable student participation. To enhance and enrich the experience for the sports analytics community, the symposium has been thoughtfully rescheduled from Fall 2023 to Spring 2024. This change marks the beginning of a new tradition, with the event set to take place in the spring seasons moving forward.
